Temple Rodef Shalom Falls Church, VA

Planning Study, Design and Documentation, Construction Administration for the expansion and renovation of a large Reform Jewish congregation outside of Washington, DC. Project was for a major expansion and renovation including a new chapel wing, a new classroom wing and a clergy suite.

Temple Emanuel Sinai Worcester, MA

Planning Study followed by Design and Documentation for renovations and additions to a recently merged congregation that would be moving into a building previously occupied by one of the two original congregations. Major renovation of sanctuary, social hall and administration offices.

Temple Emanu-El Westfield, NJ

Planning Study for large congregation looking to renovate their facility. Scope includes renovation of sanctuary, chapel, social hall and creating a café/gathering space to provide a more welcoming experience.

Society Hill Synagogue Philadelphia, PA

Design and Documentation to renovate the adjacent rowhouse and create an link and new entry for this historic assembly of buildings in Philadelphia's Society Hill. The project included the creation of new classrooms and the renovation of the social hall.
